

Renovation of the conference room & training hall no.4 in the Training and Development Center at the Engineers' Syndicate, Damascus branch

Osmane Mounif Aïdi Foundation for Culture, Communication & Development constantly seeks to support training issues, since these are crucial in the development of human resources which is a main factor in economic growth. Within this framework, the Foundation has undertook at their own expenses the renovation works of the conference room, as well as of hall no. 4 in the Training and Development Center at the Engineers' Syndicate – Damascus branch. Works were completed on August 14th, 2017.

Renovation works included expanding the **Lecture Hall** and increasing its capacity to 179 seats, as well as providing it with movable booths for simultaneous translation. In addition, floors and drop ceilings were coated with high quality materials to provide proper sound insulation and fire resistance. The marble coating of the pillars was replaced and additional lighting fixtures were mounted. Moreover, the Center was provided with a modern computer and UPS unit.

With regard to **Training Hall No.4**, it was supplied with 25 modern computers along with monitors, UPS units and a main server. The drop ceiling was coated with sound insulation and fire resistant materials. New networks for power feed cables and for data were added, as well as a projector with a screen for presentations. A modern computer with UPS has also been provided for updating the website of the Syndicate.





Renovation also included the corridor connecting between the two halls, whereby soundproof and fire resistant drop ceilings were installed, and lighting and ventilation systems underwent a comprehensive maintenance process.
